****e-Learning for Healthcare - Statutory and Mandatory e-learning programme Updates****

In 2017, Health Education England e-Learning for Healthcare (HEE e-LfH) launched a series of e-learning sessions and assessments called Statutory and Mandatory Training, which was based on learning outcomes outlined in the Skills for Health Core Skills Training Framework.

In response to user feedback, HEE e-LfH is re-designing the e-learning sessions and eAssessments to be combined into a single package to enable users to easily access both the knowledge content and e-Assessment in one session. As part of this update to the Statutory and Mandatory Training programme, HEE e-LfH is also updating the Data Security Awareness Level 1 session and eAssessment to include General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and social care updates.

The new programme will be made available from mid-October 2018.

If you are part way through completing these programmes, please be aware that the previous courses will remain accessible within an archive folder until 31 March 2019, enabling users and local administrators to access historic certificates and report on learning history.

****Horus ePortfolio – TAB****

Many foundation doctors (FDs) will be starting their Team Assessment of Behaviour (TAB) feedback collection this month. The [Horus Support Site](#) has lots of information on how to manage this in Horus.

Notes:

- If a FD has a previous rotation (for example, 2017-18 F1), they should make sure they select their current rotation when starting TAB.
- Only one 'active' TAB is possible at any one time. If a FD sees this message: "A new TAB cannot be started until the latest TAB has had a "TAB Summary" form completed." they should ask their educational supervisor/local administrator to check their previous rotation and [complete the TAB summary form](#) there.


