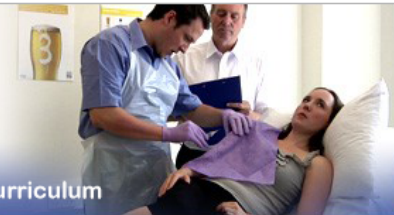

e-Portfolio

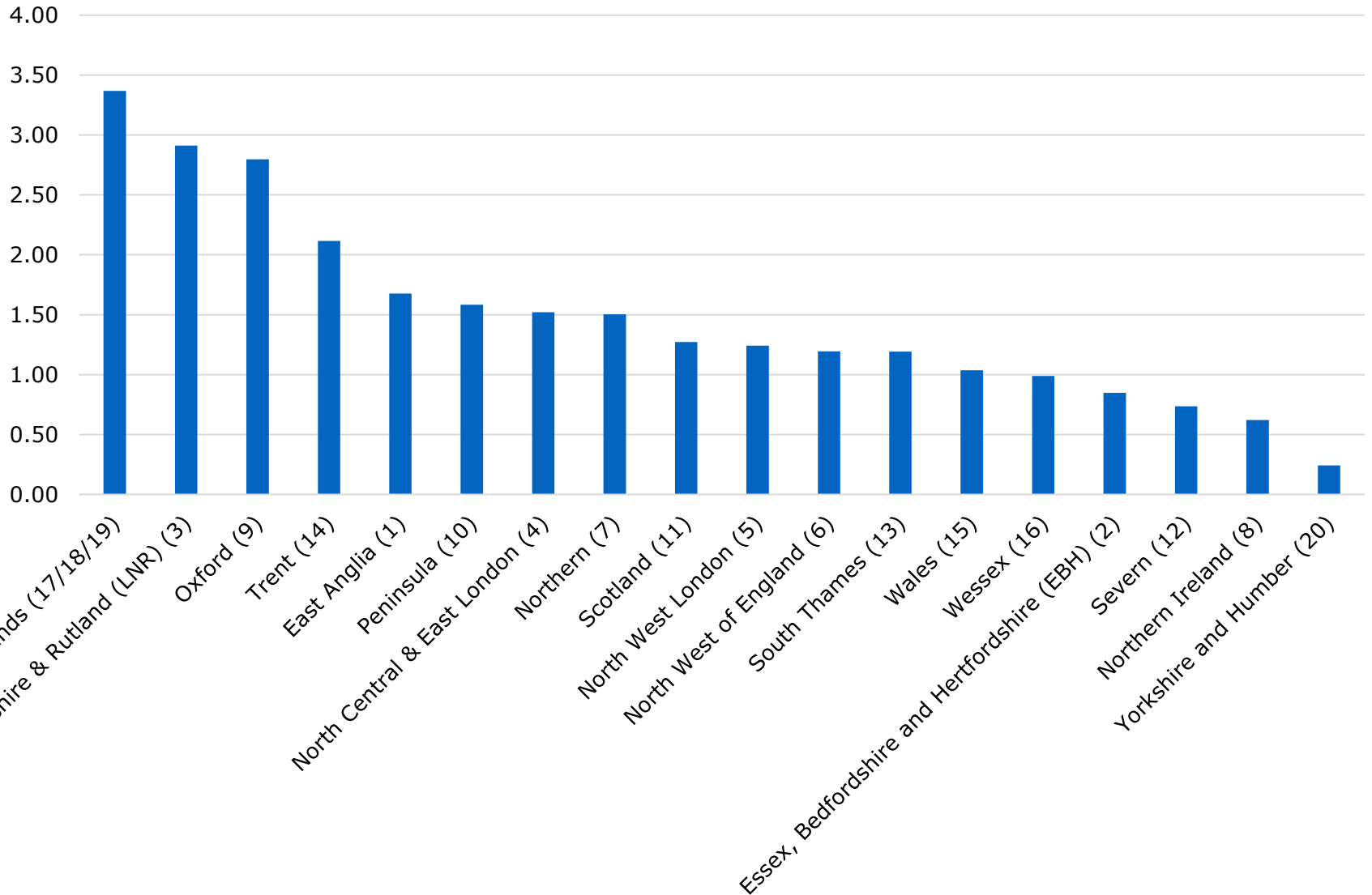
Each morning both e-Portfolios
